|  | <p>Cynthia Stamper Graff – President and CEO Lindora, Inc.</p> <p>A nationally recognized expert in the field of weight management, Cynthia Stamper Graff has been actively involved in the growth and development of Lindora, the largest multi-site medical weight control system in the United States, since 1988. A leader in integrating technology as a tool in the treatment of obesity, Ms. Graff has been instrumental in developing Lindora's clinical program as well as the online and by-phone options. In 2006, she partnered with Rite Aid to open Lindora Health Clinics inside select Rite Aid pharmacies. Ms. Graff co-authored several books including: <i>Lean for Life Phase One: Weight Loss</i>, <i>Lean for Life Phase Two: Lifetime Solutions</i>, and <i>bodyPRIDE</i>. She is the founder of the Lean for Life Foundation, a nonprofit organization that promotes obesity research and educational programs, and funds weight control services to low-income, morbidly obese men, women, and children.</p> | <p>February 19, 2009</p> |

|  | <p>Shirlene Lopez – Consultant and Former President and COO Del Taco LLC</p> <p>After a thirty year career with Del Taco, Shirlene Lopez retired as President and Chief Operating Officer in November 2008 and continues to serve Del Taco in a consulting capacity. Ms. Lopez began her tenure with Del Taco at the age of 14, wiping tables and mopping floors. By age 20, she was a training manager and shortly thereafter became part of the new store opening team. In 1989, Ms. Lopez accepted a position in the Corporate Office Personnel Department. She continued to rise through the corporate ranks becoming executive vice president in 2002. She was appointed president in 2006, six months after Del Taco was acquired by Sagittarius Brands, LLC. Her focus on the customer experience has helped shape the Del Taco culture both at the corporate office and in the restaurants where Ms. Lopez spent much of her time.
